**SOUTH PASADENA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT BECAME SMOKE-FREE.**

On August 30, 1994, the School Board approved the following Board Policy:

### **TOBACCO-FREE ENVIRONMENT**

Research has demonstrated that there are health hazards associated with all tobacco use, tobacco products, including chewing, smoking, and breathing of second-hand smoke.

The Board of Education, in compliance with AB 816, prohibits the use of tobacco products anywhere or any time within any District building, facility vehicle and on District grounds.

This policy went into effect on January 1, 1995. The District shall provide a list of clinics and community resources which may assist employees who wish to stop using tobacco products.
